Friday May 25 is our last pizza night till September starting at 6 pm. Come on down and join the crowd.

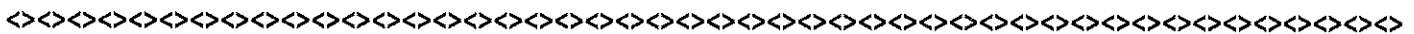
